# This might NOT be the time to renovate!

This might be an odd statement to hear coming from the Renovating Realtor, however, in my opinion, this is not the time to renovate unless it is necessary.

**THIS PANDEMIC** has made prices increase in most consumer products. However, some of the highest price increases are in the housing sector. As we all know, home prices in the GTA and elsewhere have skyrocketed. This has led to many homeowners fixing their homes up either in hopes of obtaining a higher price when they sell or to avoid the steep cost of moving to a larger home in this frantic market.

Stay at home orders have caused homeowners to look more closely at their homes and want to improve them. The result of all of these factors is that the desire for home improvements has never been greater.

As a result, homeowners are flocking to hardware and supply stores to make improvements to their homes or seeking out a good contractor to do the work. When they do, the universal reaction is shock. Little projects can cost a fortune.

The cost of lumber is unbelievable. Lumber has increased by nearly 40% from last year. According to Natural Resources Canada, Eastern spruce-pine-fir two-by-fours were selling for \$1,400 per thousand board feet in March 2021, and Western spruce-pine-fir two-by-fours for \$1,200. In March 2020, these prices were between \$550 and \$600 per thousand board feet. This is a huge increase that will drastically change the budget of your renovation or new home build. New homes in the GTA are expected to add close to \$36,000 to new builds due to the increased cost.

On top of high costs, the supply chain is currently

unreliable. Tile, electrical components, tools, trim, windows, insulation etc. are not available in the same way they were before the pandemic. This can result in materials not arriving on time or even at all during a renovation. For example, there is currently a surge in demand for drywall despite the huge price increase and, the big box stores cannot keep it on their shelves and cannot restock it fast enough to meet demand. Therefore, simple things like hooking up new breakers in your panel could take months instead of hours. All these delays compound and add up to more and more time your renovation may take to complete.

Lastly, trades are charging more for two reasons. First, the demand for contractors is very high so securing a good contractor means that you will be paying them a lot more than what you would have paid when there was less demand. Second, doing a renovation in today's climate takes much more work and planning. For example, dealing with curbside and phone-in orders adds a lot more time, which is charged to the customer.

My advice to you if you're thinking of doing a renovation, (advice I never thought I would give) is to postpone an optional renovation. Wait until supply and pricing stabilize, which is expected to occur in 2022. Once you start a renovation, you're pretty much committed to its completion. The last thing you would want to do is take a bathroom offline for months when it should normally have been weeks. However, if your situation permits and you can handle the overages and time delays, then go for it! Just make sure you know what you're getting into before the first hammer goes through the drywall.



ongratulations on purchasing a home in such competitive times. The more organized home Buyers can be as closing day on a home purchase nears the better. After successfully buying the home with an accepted Agreement of Purchase, and Sale provide the lawyer and lender with all paperwork required without delay. The REALTOR\* contracted for the purchase can help in this process. Contact the utility companies to inform them of the closing date and changeover required, and complete necessary transition paperwork. Contact the post office to inform them of a change of address required. Many of the services needed can be accessed online.

Check the town or city website for extra information available for residents moving to the area. There will be resources for parks and recreation, garbage and recycling collection, fire permits, building planning, dog licensing, property taxes, fire and rescue services, parking and other by-laws and much more.

Purge unnecessary and unused or forgotten items in advance of the move, so there's less to pack. Donate items where possible and trash the remaining where necessary in advance of closing day. At each buyer visit the home may look different, and creating a to-do list of changes, plans, measurements, and ideas will help when the list is later prioritized by importance

Fragile goods, priceless items, jewelry and other valuables should be boxed separately and kept safely with the Buyer(s) to move on their own to limit risk. Keep all identification documents in a safe, accessible location as these documents will be needed again before closing day.

When boxing up belongings work room by room and label as thoroughly as possible, which may help speed up the unboxing and organizing in the new space. Movers or moving helpers should ideally be booked after the official closing date in case the official closing doesn't occur until late in the day.

While the home purchased may be left tidy and in broom swept condition cleaning each room to exacting standards and freshening up the air will be much easier while the home is empty. Arriving with cleaning supplies and equipment to get floors, surfaces and cabinets, washrooms and more shining before you unload belongings will already improve the moving experience. Buyers planning changes to wall colour, flooring and beyond find it easier to finish these home improvements prior to moving in officially.

If the weather is warmer, plan to enjoy the yard and assess if decks and fences will need refinishing or repair for the safety of those living in the home. Check if the gutters require cleaning and if extenders will be needed to divert precipitation collection away from the home.

Closing day is a perfect day to change batteries in smoke detectors, and each floor should have a working unit that has not expired. The laundry area

gets so much use, and initially, if there is an existing dryer, pull the unit away and thoroughly clean the dryer vent duct area from the machine to the home exterior. Lint collects in these vents and is highly flammable. This is often the time when buyers may opt to additionally have their air ducts cleaned to improve the quality of airflow in the home.

Personalizing the house will make it feel like a home in no time, and the hard work in moving will be well worth the time and organized effort.



Real Estate Market Update – Aurora



## **Steady Push For Home Sweet Home**

igorous Home sales continued in April, ending the month with 190 homes sold firm in Aurora, 3 more than last month and a whopping 375% increase in purchases over last year when many froze from taking action in the real estate market to purchase in wake of COVID-19 concerns.

The median price for all home types in Aurora was \$1,200,000, marginally up from March. At the end of the month, there were 152 homes available to purchase, with 268 homes placed on the market in total. Approximately 15 percent fewer homes were placed for sale in April compared to March. This, in part, maybe due to the COVID-19 stay-at-home order across the province of Ontario. What we can see is Buyers are still taking action, and Sellers in April typically received 105 percent of their asking price with homes selling on average within 10 days. What were the average prices for detached homes in Aurora? There were 125 detached homes purchased, and 95 of them were two storeys at a median price of \$1,350,000.

Year-to-date sales numbers are up by 110 percent over 2020. There have been 575 sales in Aurora at a

median price of \$1,165,000 for all home types compared to \$889,000 at the end of April 2020, and homes are on average selling ten days sooner at 13 days on the market. There have been 71 percent more homes available to choose from for sale in 2021 as well, so with safety top of mind in these COVID-19 challenging times and vaccination roll-outs steadily improving more homes may be placed for sale in the coming months.

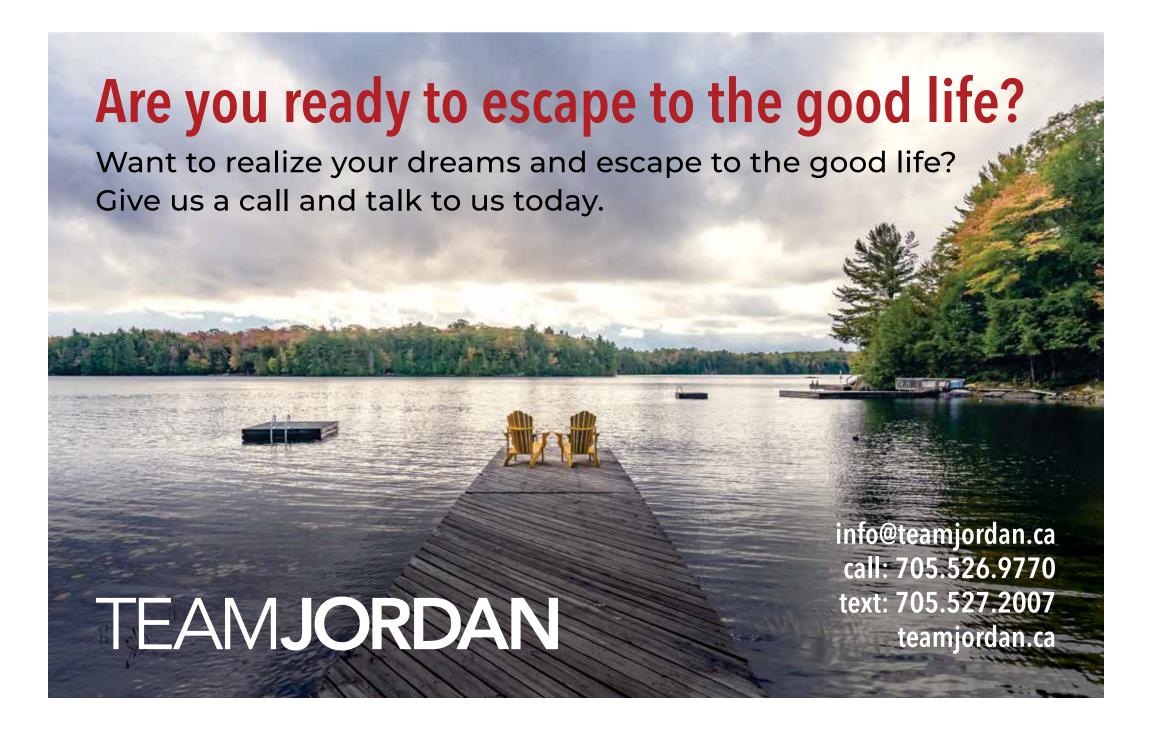




